Tuesday, March 9:

Depart from your local area en route to Lincoln, NE and a tour of the International Quilt Study Center and Museum, followed by a stop at the nearby Larsen Tractor Museum which includes over 40 antique tractors. Both interesting tours are located on the east campus of the University of Nebraska Lincoln.
